This is to inform all parents and students that **PKS Public School, Chiraiyakot, Mau** is organizing the **PKS Pratibha Kiran Scholarship Examination 2026–27** to identify and encourage students' talents in **co-curricular activities along with academics**.

Eligibility

- Students from **Class I to Class IX** are eligible.
- **Eligible Candidates: Outside School Students Only**



Co-Curricular Categories Included

1. Dance (Any TWO Types)

- Classical / Semi-Classical
- Folk / Western

Judgement Based On: Rhythm, expression, coordination, creativity, confidence, and stage presence.

2. Singing (Any TWO Types)

- Classical / Semi-Classical
- Folk / Light Music



Assessment Criteria: Voice quality, sur, taal, clarity, modulation, and presentation.

3. Speaking / Speaker (Hindi & English – Any TWO Types)

- Speech
- Storytelling / Elocution / Extempore



Evaluation Based On: Confidence, clarity of speech, pronunciation, content, fluency, expression, and presentation.

4. Art & Craft (Any TWO Types)

- Drawing / Painting
- Colouring / Paper Craft / Creative Art



Judgement Criteria: Creativity, originality, neatness, colour sense, innovation, and presentation.

Time Duration

- **Each activity/performance:** Minimum **1 minute** to Maximum **5 minutes**
- **Total Examination Duration:** **90 Minutes**

Scholarship Benefits

Selected students will receive **scholarship benefits, certificates, medals, and special recognition** under the **PKS Pratibha Kiran Scholarship Scheme 2026–27**, as per school norms.

Important Instructions

- ▶ Candidates must bring their **admit card** on the examination day.
- ▶ Participants must bring their **own stationery, music tracks, and required art materials**.
- ▶ Students must report to the examination centre **at least 30 minutes before commencement**.
- ▶ **Reporting Time:** 09:00 AM
- ▶ **Gate Closing Time:** 10:30 AM
- ▶ Total duration of the examination will be **90 minutes**.

▶ **Dress Code: Formal dress compulsory. Participants of Dance / Singing may wear suitable performance costumes, arranged and brought from home.**

▶ The examination will be conducted in a **fair, transparent, and disciplined manner.**

▶ Selection will be made **strictly on merit and seat availability.**

▶ The decision of the **judges and school management shall be final and binding.**

▶ Parents should ensure **regular attendance after admission.**

▶ Any misconduct may result in **cancellation or withdrawal of scholarship benefits.**

✓ Report to the examination centre **on time.**

✓ Carry **admit card and necessary stationery/materials.**

✓ Follow the **instructions given by invigilators and judges.**

✓ Maintain **discipline, silence, and proper behaviour.**

✓ Perform within the **given time limit (2–5 minutes).**

✓ Ensure your **music track is ready and properly labeled** (if applicable).

✓ Wear **formal and decent dress** suitable for the event.

✓ Respect fellow participants, teachers, and staff members.

✘ DON'Ts

✘ Do not wear **school uniform or inappropriate dress.**

✘ Do not exceed the **maximum time limit** during performance.

✘ Do not use **unfair means or external assistance.**

✘ Do not create noise, disturbance, or indiscipline.

✘ Do not argue with judges or staff regarding evaluation.

✘ Do not leave the examination area without permission.

✘ Do not damage school property or disturb others' performances.
